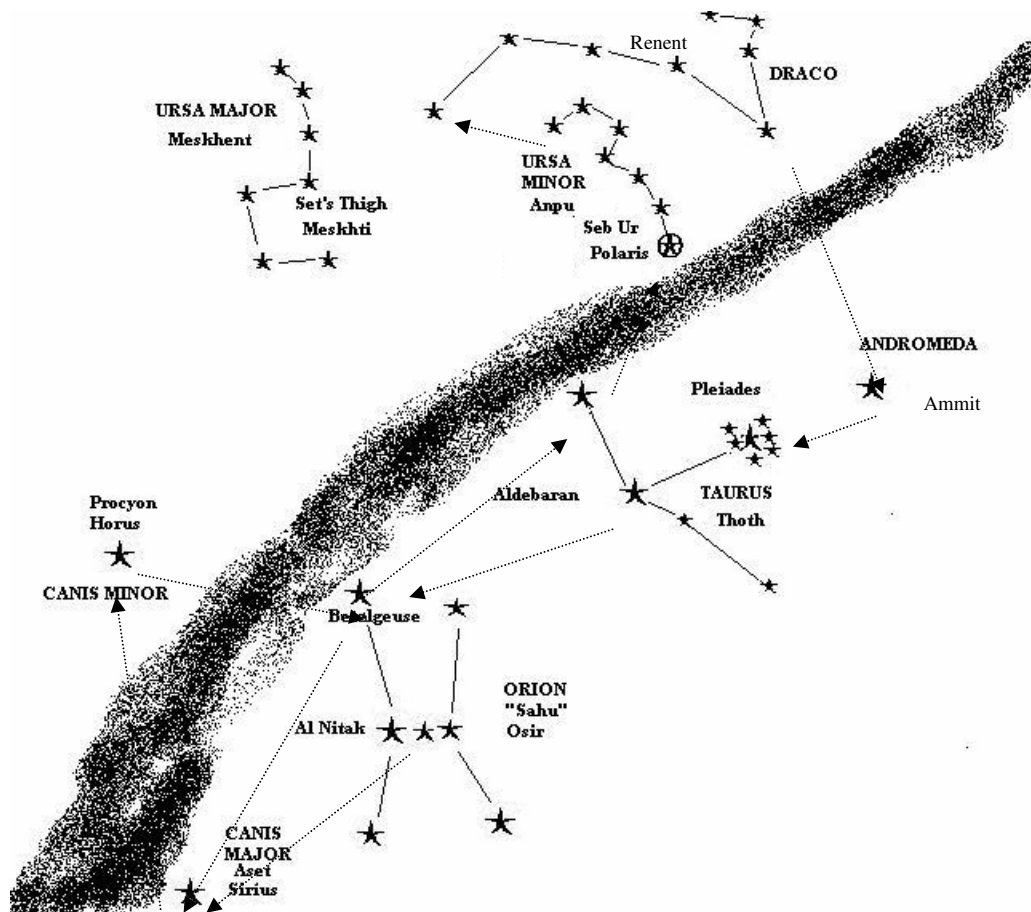


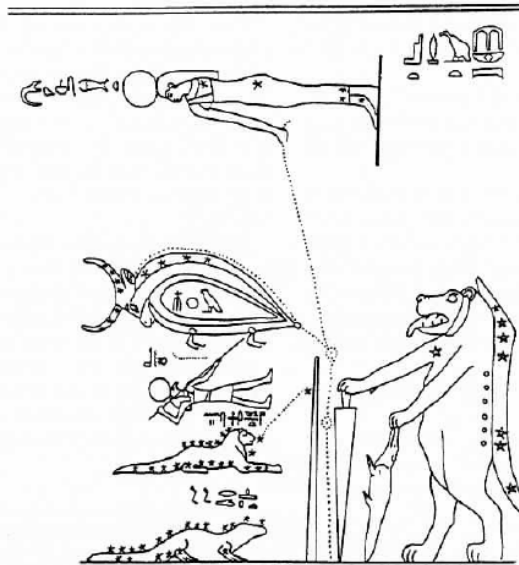
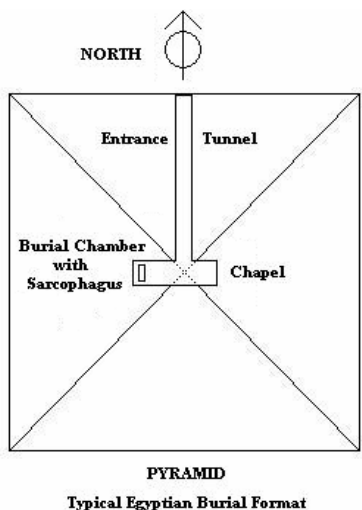

The tip of Taurus' Horn balances Milky Way (Heavenly Nile). Choice: Return via Milky Way (Nut semen/soul flow) to Polestar (Anpu/Duat) for Reincarnation or Join the Khus of Light. Tekhuti balances the choice and records the decision. The Abode of the Soul of Set was Meskhiti, the 7-star Great Bear constellation symbolized as a bull's haunch. The Meskhent thigh and the Seb-Ur (Big Star) dipper-shaped crowbar tool of Set were used in the Opening of the Mouth Ceremony. Opening the Mouth represented spiritual Birth. Meskhent was the birthplace and the midwife goddess. The Great Midwife (Meskhent Aait) was the Hippo Goddess. Meskhenti were the birth bricks. Set thus is the Polestar and represents the power of conception, the point of incarnation into this planet.

The royal coffin was placed in its sarcophagus with the pharaoh's head toward the north. A chapel on the eastern side of the burial chambers welcomed the sunrise. The burial chamber was on the western side where the sun set. The king's soul left through the crown chakra and went to the Duat as Osiris where he was received by Anpu (Anubis), the Little Dipper. One of the stars in that constellation served as the Pole Star – Seb Ur, the Great Star. This Star marked with a circle was the entrance to the Duat from whence the king would reincarnate as a new pharaoh. It also marked the peak of the pyramid or pyramidion, the Eye of Ra or Eye of Horus. This would become the sun at midday. The radiating corners of the pyramid became the rays of sunlight. The little Dipper was the tool for opening the Mouth. It also represented the new baby connected by its umbilicus to the Pole Star as the Hanged Man (Fetal Horus). The Big Dipper was called the Thigh of Set (Khepesh) and acted like the hand on a clock, tracking the millions of years and watching for each rebirth as the Midwife, Meskhent. She delivers the new baby, Baba or Horus. Then He-sa-mut (“Mother with the Braid Down her Back” or “Milk Mother”), a large Hippo Goddess (Draco) takes over as Nurse Reret or Renent. She often has a crocodile on her back to symbolize the indoctrinations that she will pass on to the child. Serqet, the Scorpion Goddess, also stands by to help. In the Denderah zodiac we see mischievous infant Horus-Pharaoh sitting on top of the Scales of Ma'at just as the baboon Qefnut does. From Draco he passes through Cepheus and by Cassiopeia to Andromeda, a constellation drawn by the Egyptians as a chimera-like creature made of a combination of several animals. This is the teenage rebel who resists authority. Then, under the guidance of Thoth (Taurus) he aligns with his Pleiadian ancestry and becomes a mature, responsible leader. Passing through Aldebaran he reaches his full bull-power. Then he begins the transition from Horus to Osiris as he passes on to Betelgeuse, the “Red Ear” in the head of Orion. (SAH). This is where he attains immortality. Al Nitak, forms the tip of his phallus. With this he impregnates Isis (Sirius) who then gives birth to Horus (Procyon). In death the spirit of the Horus Pharaoh becomes Osiris and passes northward along the stream of the Milky Way as semen to conceive another version of himself at the Pole Star.

Horus also achieved the Eye. But Baba and Thoth helped Osiris to resurrection and immortality. Baba was known as “Red Ear” (Desher Mestcher) and was the link from Osiris and Isis to Set and his wife, Nebt-Het. Mes-tcher literally means “birth-boundary”. Setchem (hearing) puns with Set-Hemt, Set's wife. Set-Hem also means Set's testicle. The Eye of Horus was injured by Set and restored by Thoth. This is the Eye of Immortality. The Fingers of Baba help Osiris up the ladder to Heaven. The Tongue of Baba is his phallus. The Ministrants are forms of Baba and refer to tantric techniques.

The 36 Dekans plus Sirius (Sepdet): A First Draft Correlation with the Zodiac Signs

1. Tepi'A-Kenmut Waxing Ape (Kenmut = Qefdenu, Gemini, Thoth's pal).
Thoth as a baboon hails the new year or new cycle.
2. Kenmut (Thoth's baboon form) (Gemini ascendant)
3. Kher-khept-Kenmut Waning Kenmut (Gemini waning)
4. H*a'-Tchat Ferryboat (Cancer waxing)
5. Peh*ui-Tchat End of Ferryboat (Cancer waning)
6. Themat-h*ert Upper Warrior (Leo waxing)
7. Themat-ger Lower Warrior (Leo waning)
8. Ustha Mighty Woman (Virgo)
9. Bekatha Pregnant Woman, Light of Dawn (Virgo Pregnant)
10. Tepi'A-Khentet Waxing of the Harem (Virgo giving birth, Libra waxing)
(Virgo is Isis bearing her children. After the birth of Horus she hid in the papyrus swamp to escape Set's wrath. The papyrus swamp can also be the secluded harem or a prison. The "Register" can be the writ issued by Set condemning Horus to death -- Scorpio. He sends scorpion troops to kill Horus.)
11. Khentet-h*ert The Harem Ascendant (Libra Ascendant)
12. Khentet-khert Waning of the Harem (Libra waning)
13. Themes-n-khentet Register of the Harem (Libra become a library)
14. Sa-pet-khennu Prophet of the Wisdom (Back) of Heaven (Scorpio Waxing). Horus (Ophiuchus) holding serpents and scorpions as his toys. The Wisdom of Thoth conquers death, removing its sting. Isis and Nebthys support from behind.
15. Her-ab-uaa In the Center of the Boat (Scorpio ascendant)
16. Shesmu Judge, Executioner of Osiris (Scorpio waning)
17. Kenmu (Another form of Kenmut?) (Sagittarius)
18. Smedet Halfway (Sagittarius)
19. Tepi'A-smed Great Primary of (Second) Half (Sagittarius)
20. Sert The Ram of Capricorn
21. Sasa-Sert Sons of Capricorn
22. Kher-khept-Sert Lower End of Capricorn
23. Khukhu The Light Beings (Aquarius)
24. Baba Babaji, first son of Osiris (Aquarius)
25. Khent-Heru High Chief, Horus, second son of Osiris (Aquarius)
